

Lodging Rates & Information

Lodging and meals are per person, per day and include all taxes and gratuities. Meals include Wednesday dinner, Thursday breakfast, lunch and dinner, and Friday breakfast and lunch. Rates for the 2017 conference include:

Rates are per person, per night. Non-profit and other state tax exempt units do not pay the 6% sales tax with proof of status, although local tax (2%) and resort fees (7%) still apply. Mountain Villa rates (condos) are based on the number of persons per bedroom, not per condominium unit. Condominium rates also include all meals. Lodging reservations are on a first come, first served basis.

Room Reservation Deadline

The room reservation deadline was August 27. Please contact Boyne Mountain directly to ask about getting the conference room rate for any available rooms.

MiCAMP uses a single fee system that includes membership and all conference registration fees for up to 10 persons from your organization. Listed below are the current membership and conference fee categories:
